Since 2006, The Mind Trust has worked to transform Indianapolis into one of the best-positioned cities in the country to give every student access to a great school.

24 We've supported the launch of 24 schools serving 8,448 students. These include **16 Innovation Network Schools** and **8 Independent Charter Schools**.

We've raised over \$108 million to support education in Indianapolis.

100 We've provided over 100 schools with expert supports.

1,400 We've supported the placement of over 1,400 educators in Indianapolis through Teach For America and TNTF's Indianapolis Teaching Fellows.

50 We've hosted over 50 community events and countless meetings to elevate important education issues to the Indianapolis community.

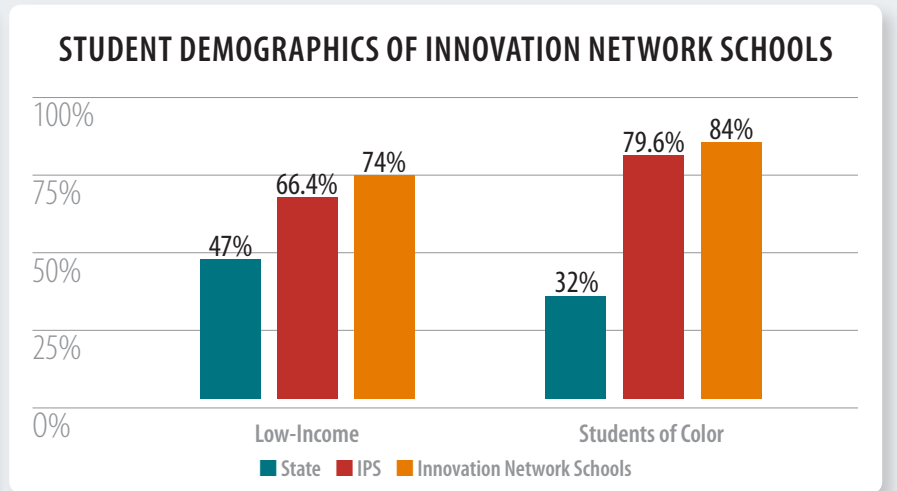
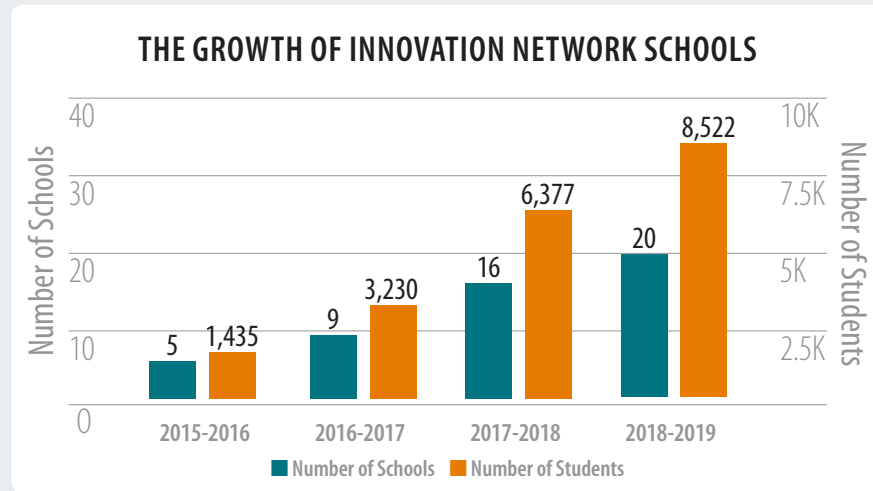

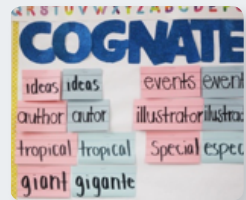
In partnership with Indianapolis Public Schools (IPS) and the Mayor's Office of Education Innovation, we've made Innovation Network Schools a national model.

20 There are now 20 Innovation Network Schools in IPS, serving nearly 28 percent of IPS students.

15% Enrollment has increased by almost 15 percent at IPS schools that have converted to or restarted as Innovation Network Schools.

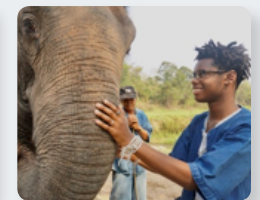
